NEONATAL RESUSCITATION PROGRAMME™ *(NRP)*

Introduction

The Penang Adventist Hospital Life Support Education Centre (PAH LSEC) has adopted the Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP) using the guidelines of the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP), the American Heart Association (AHA) and the Perinatal Society of Malaysia (PSM). This programme is designed to reevaluate medical professionals as NRP providers and to renew/update their skills in the management of neonatal resuscitation. Participants will gain hands on experience in code management during the practice sessions.

Objectives

At completion of the course, participants will be able to demonstrate proficiency according to the AAP, AHA and the PSM standards in the areas of:

- Initial Steps in Resuscitation: Thermal Management, Positioning, Suctioning and Tactile Stimulation
- Anesthesia Resuscitation and use of a Resuscitation Bag and Mask
- Chest Compressions
- Endotracheal Intubation
- Medications
- Special Consideration
- Resuscitation of Pre-term babies
- Care of after life
